Release 9.0.0-15

The 9.0.0-15 release resolves issues with:

- Appliance updates
- Active jobs queue
- Backups
- Migration to CentOS6
- Recovering synthetic backups
- Recovering VMware virtual machines
- Recovering XenServer virtual machines
- ReliableDR testing
- Replication
- Reports
- Security (PCI vulnerabilities)
- Storage

Release 9.0.0-13

Release 9.0.0-13 introduces new features and resolves issues with logging, purging and replication. New features include:

SQL 2016 protection. Release 9.0.0-13 extends SQL support to include protection of SQL 2016 instances. In
this release, SQL 2016 is supported for the same functionality as SQL 2014. New features introduced in SQL
2016 are not supported. (Note that the current UI supports protection of SQL 2016 Always Encrypted and Stretch
databases. Consider moving to the new UI to protect these SQL 2016 databases.)

To protect your SQL 2016 databases:



- The Unitrends appliance must be running release 9.0.0-13 or higher.
- The SQL client must be running Windows agent release 9.0.0-13 or higher.
- Exchange 2016 protection. Release 9.0.0-13 extends Exchange support to include protection of Exchange 2016 databases. In this release, Exchange 2016 is supported for the same functionality as Exchange 2013. New features introduced in Exchange 2016, such as Office 365 and hybrid deployments, are not supported.

To protect your Exchange 2016 databases:

- The Unitrends appliance must be running release 9.0.0-13 or higher.
- The Exchange client must be running Windows agent release 9.0.0-13 or higher.
- New features in the current UI. If you are using the legacy UI to protect environments that were not yet available in the current UI, see this list of newly supported features to determine whether you can move to the current UI. Support for the following have been added to the current UI in release 9.0.0-13:
 - iSeries protection
 - Cisco UCS service profile protection
 - NAS protection using the NDMP protocol
 - Asset grouping. If you have configured Navigation Groups in the legacy UI, these groups display in the current UI while in Show Groups view. Group names, colors, and user settings created in the legacy UI apply to these groups in the current UI.

Release 9.0.0-12

Release 9.0.0-12 introduces new Windows and Linux agents, performance enhancements, and resolves issues with NDMP, CloudHook, UI, restore, archiving, purging and synthesis. In addition, the Support toolbox, which gives the user access to additional information as well as access to perform system tasks, AD integration, iSCSI with CHAP, and the ability to change the OS password, is now available in the current UI.

Release 9.0.0-11

Release 9.0.0-11 introduces new features, performance enhancements, and resolves issues with backups, archiving, Oracle protection, VMware protection, purging, synthesis, storage, and UEB deployment.

- Mac OS 10.11 El Capitan protection. Release 9.0.0-11 extends Mac OS support to include file-level protection of Mac OS 10.11. To protect your Mac OS 10.11 environment:
 - The Unitrends appliance must be running release 9.0.0-11 or higher.
 - The Mac client must be running agent release 9.0.0 or higher.

- **Novell OES Linux 11 protection**. Release 9.0.0-11 extends Novell OES Linux support to include file-level protection of version 11. To protect your Novell OES Linux 11 environment:
 - The Unitrends appliance must be running release 9.0.0-11 or higher.
 - The Novell OES Linux client must be running agent release 9.0.0 or higher.

Release 9.0.0-9

Release 9.0.0-9 resolves issues with backups, backup copies, purging, Windows Instant Recovery, and deploying UEB virtual appliances.

Release 9.0.0-8

The 9.0.0-8 release resolves an issue with scheduled jobs not running at the expected times.

The 9.0.0-6 release resolves issues with:
