


IPMI Config from the BIOS and Attaching your Unitrends Appliance to the Network

- 1) Shut Down System
- 2) Find the IPMI Port on the back of the Unitrends appliance and plug a network cable to that port




- 3)
- 4) Boot System and hit the Del (Delete) key on the Keyboard to enter the BIOS setup.




- 5) If asked for a password when entering the BIOS use "backup" all lower case.




- 6) In the BIOS Setup Utility use the Arrow keys on the keyboard to navigate to the Advanced Tab



- 7) Arrow down to the IPMI Configuration



- 8) Chose the "Set LAN Configuration"




- 9) Configure the IP Address for
 a. Set IP Address Source to Static

b. Configure IP Address, Subnet Mask, and Gateway




c. NOT THE SAME IP ADDRESS AS THE UNITRENDS APPLIANCE

10) Press F10 to Save Changes and Exit and hit OK



11) Allow the system to reboot

12) Navigate to the IP Address that you set in the BIOS



13) Default log in is username: ADMIN password: ADMIN

14) Your IPMI is now configured, Enjoy!
