
Product Name: Passly Windows Logon Agent

Description: This Agent Procedure will allow you to deploy Passly on your Windows environment from the VSA.

Import Agent Procedures

Agent Procedure -> Schedule / Create – Import Folder/Procedure

When you Run or Schedule the Procedure - It will prompt for the HomeRealm, Client ID and Client Key in order to automate the entire process. (Make sure to not enter "https://" when entering the HomeRealm as it will install anyway but will fail to connect to your server)
